

## COVID-19 CARES Act Emergency Funds – Students – 3<sup>rd</sup> Round (08/13/20-09/15/20)

**As of 08/11/2020**

**Amount disbursed to students: \$214,145**

**Students who received funds: 277**

\*Students enrolled during Spring 2020 semester as of March 13, 2020 and completed the Spring 2020 semester with at least one course that was a “seated” or hybrid course. These students must have a valid & complete 19/20 FAFSA on file.

\*Students may receive a maximum amount of \$1,500. If students have already received funds in Round 1 or Round 2, the amount will be adjusted to still adhere to the \$1,500 maximum

\*Completion of HEERF Request Form (updated & available via Dynamic Forms 08/13/2020)

\*Students are required to certify and attest that they have incurred or will incur allowable expenses of food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, childcare, transportation, and/or any other item included in Cost of Attendance as a result of the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus via an acknowledgement on the HEERF Request Form.

\*Students enrolled and attending at least one campus-based course (at the time of disbursement) for Fall 2020 semester. These students must have a valid & complete 20/21 FAFSA on file. **As a new technology requirement has been implemented campus-wide for students in direct relation to the uncertainty of campus life due to COVID-19 and a possible outbreak (either campus-wide, dormitories, or certain classrooms), we are allowing students that have completed a HEERF Request Form and indicate they do not have the current financial means to purchase the technology requirement to be eligible to receive HEERF Funds so they can make such a purchase or reimburse themselves for the purchase.** This is a new requirement that has never been requested from student prior to the Fall 2020 semester. The new requirement was not announced until a few weeks prior to classes starting and most of our student population was already enrolled prior to the new technology requirement being announced.
