

COVID-19 CARES Act Emergency Funds – Students – 2nd Round (06/30/20)

SCCC will only award CARES Funding to students with a valid & complete FAFSA on file, enrolled in a Title IV eligible program, meet all Title IV eligibility standards, and meeting SAP standards as of the date of the award.

*Students enrolled during Summer 2020 semester provided they are enrolled in at least one course that was initially offered as ground-based but was moved to on-line instruction. These students will be automatically awarded \$300 unless they were previously provided HEERF funds. If a student received HEERF funds for the Spring 2020 semester, the total award cannot exceed the max of \$1,500/student and the Summer amount will be adjusted. These students must have a valid & complete 19/20 FAFSA on file.

An email will be sent to all students identified informing them of the HEERF funds are to be used for the following allowable expenses: must be related to the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19. They include: Food, Housing, Course materials, Technology and computer hardware, Health care, Dependent care, Transportation, Other expenses considered in the cost of attendance

All funds will be paid directly to the student via paper check to the address on record in SCCC's Banner Database System unless otherwise informed by student to mail the check to a different temporary address.
