Color Run for cousin of SCCC's Austin

As some of you may have seen on Facebook or on the news, SCCC Respiratory Therapy instructor Arlette Austin's cousin Jesse Mendez from Perryton, Texas, was in a horrific oil field related accident on Oct. 1. Arlette emailed that Jesse "suffered severe third degree burns to 80% of his body. He is in critical condition in Lubbock, Texas in the burn ICU at UMC. My heart is broken, but I am so grateful that he is alive."

Doctors stated that if he would have inhaled just a little bit more of the fire/smoke he would have died. Arlette's siblings Kenia Mendez, Junior Mendez, and other Mendez cousins from Perryton have come together to host a fundraiser in honor of Jesse, his wife, and children to help cover expenses during these difficult times.

"It will be a fun color run event for everyone and all ages from kids to adults, runners or nonrunners! If you are able to make it, that would be awesome," Arlette wrote. "We are also gratefully accepting goodwill donations. Thank you from the bottom of my heart!"
