Welcome to Kids College

Welcome to a world of imagination at Seward County Community College! We offer a week of quality enrichment opportunities, as well as academically stimulating courses at Kids College. Kids College runs from July 13 – 16, with 3 sessions: 8:00am - 9:15am, 9:30am - 10:45am, and 11:00am - 12:15pm.



Kids College is for students entering 1st through 8th grade. Check out all the new classes we have to offer. We know you will find something of interest for your child.

The instructors and staff are looking forward to being a part of your child's summer experiences. *Remember to register early since classes are limited and fill quickly.*

We want your child to have fun and stay safe. Because college is an adult environment, our trained staff will supervise your child at all times. Please help your child enjoy our program by following these guidelines:

Register Early

Kids College registration will be conducted in the Business & Industry office, located in the Industrial Technology Campus, T Building, 2215 N. Kansas. Please call the office 620.417.1170 between the hours of 7:45am – 4:45pm Monday – Friday. **Please notice summer hours starting Monday, May 18, 7:30am – 5:30pm Monday - Thursday.** Classes are offered on a first-registered, first-paid basis. ***All fees must be paid when registering.*** Fees are \$25 per class.

Drop off and pick up point

All children will gather outside the Student Union 10 minutes before every class. ***Please do not drop your child off any earlier than 7:45 am.*** SCCC will not have adult supervision until then. Instructors will meet with the students, take them to class, and return with them after class ends. B&I staff will wait with your children as they are picked up from inside the Student Union. Children will not be allowed to walk to

the parking lot without supervision. If you will be late in picking up your child, please call the B&I office at (620) 417-1173 to inform us of your arrival time. If you arrive late, you will find your child in the Student Union. Safety is important to us, and we cannot assume responsibility for your child beyond scheduled class and supervised times.

Safety/Security

Your child's safety is of the utmost importance to us. That is why we never let your child out of the sight of our teachers or staff. We ask that you never leave your child unattended while at SCCC. **Please do not ask your child to wait for you at the parking lot or another area on the SCCC campus to meet you other than the Student Union.**

Attendance

Students are expected to attend each class in which they are enrolled. They are to be in those

classes except during breaks. Parents should notify us in advance if a child will be absent. Class rolls will be taken daily, and parents will be contacted if there is an unaccounted absence.

Student conduct

Our policy requires that disruptive students leave the class. If necessary, we will call a parent to pick up the child immediately. If we ask you not to bring the child back to the class because of disruptive or threatening behavior, you will not receive a refund for the class.

Age-Appropriate

As you look through the schedule, you will see age-appropriate categories. Students must choose classes that include the grade level the child will be entering in the fall of 2026. The courses are designed to be age-specific and coincide with the socialization aspect of the program. Our instructors and administrators request that parents follow the age-appropriate guidelines listed for each class. We reserve the right to reassign your child to a grade appropriate class. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Pizza and Swim Party

On the last day, Kids College will host a pizza and swim party ONLY for students enrolled in the Kids College program for that week. The pizza party will begin immediately at 12:15 pm. The swim party follows and will end at 2:00 pm. Please send your child with a towel and swimsuit on Thursday, July 16. Swimsuits must be worn in the pool – no street clothes.

Refunds

A full refund, minus a \$5 processing fee, will be made for registrations canceled on or before Monday, July 6. Refunds cannot be made for cancellations received after July 6.

The College expects all classes to be presented as scheduled. However, a class could be canceled due to low enrollment. A decision about cancellation is made the Thursday before the start date of the class. In the event that a class is canceled, every effort will be made to either place your child in another program of his/her choice or provide a full refund.
